The Center for Education of Global Communication (CEGLOC) at the University of Tsukuba is seeking part-time lecturers to teach Spanish during the fall semester of 2018 Academic Year.

1. Work Location:

University of Tsukuba, Tsukuba Campus, CEGLOC, Foreign Language Education Division From Tsukuba Station (Tsukuba Express Line / 10-minute bus ride)

2. Responsibilities:

a. Two or four 75-minute Spanish classes per week on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays* (15 weeks from early October to early February), for mixed groups of Japanese and non-Japanese students, taught in English or Spanish.

*These classes are taught on Tuesdays from 8:40 to 9:55 (basic grammar) and from 13:45 to 15:00 (basic conversation) and on Thursdays from 8:40 to 9:55 (intermediate grammar and conversation) and from 12:15 to 13:30 (basic conversation).

- b. Collection and posting of grade records.
- c. Curriculum development and other duties required by the center.

3. Number of positions: one or two

4. Qualifications

- a. Master's or Doctoral degree.
- b. Native or near-native speaker of Spanish with strong teaching skills in English or Spanish.
- c. Applicants are required not to be enrolled in any university master's or doctoral program from October 2018 onward.
- d. Non-Japanese applicants are required to have a valid working visa in Japan.

5. Documents for application

- (1) Curriculum Vitae (Form 3), including a detailed description of the applicant's educational background, academic and other professional activities, date of birth, nationality, home addresses, telephone number, and email address.
- (2) List of teaching experiences within the last three years (Form 5)
