Faculty of Library, Information and Media Science at the University of Tsukuba invites applications for a position of Assistant Professor who will conduct research in a JST CREST project “Design and Deployment of a xDiversity AI platform for Audio-Visual-Tactile Communication towards an inclusive society” (PI: Yoichi Ochiai). In the project, we will realize integration of complementation (viewing / listening / touching) of human spatial recognition ability and complement of spatial interference ability (moving objects / communicating information with sound and light / moving the body) through researchers’ collaboration, and will design AI for people’s capacity expansion and capacity complementation. Specifically, robust connections, we will work on prototype and field verification (workshop and open source hardware recipe release) by using machine learning system or embodied robotics / audio-visual tactile sense. We are aiming to acquire followers that will contribute to the emergence of innovation and to expand collaboration in those fields. Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST) is an independent public body of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).
