4 Graduate Program Completion

(1) Master's Programs

(i) Requirements for Master's degrees

The Graduate School Steering Committee reviews the academic records of students who meet all the following requirements and determines whether to award them master's degrees:

- The student has enrolled in his/her Master's Program for at least two years.
- The student has earned at least 30 credits for the courses required for a degree specified in the relevant division's detailed rules.
- The student has completed and submitted his/her master's thesis or any specific research assignment under the direction of a member of the Graduate Faculty.
- The submitted thesis or assignment has received a passing grade.
- The student has passed the final examinations.
- Note that a student who has achieved excellent research results may be allowed to complete the Program earlier than scheduled (early completion, not applicable at some programs).

(i) Requirements for doctorates (4- to 5-year Programs)

The Graduate School Steering Committee reviews the academic records of students who meet all the following requirements and determines whether to award them doctorates:

- The student has enrolled in his/her Doctoral Program for at least five years (or four years if he/she is in one of the medical science programs).
- The student has earned at least 30 credits for the courses required for a doctorate specified in the relevant division's detailed rules (each Graduate School has its own requirements).
- The student has completed and submitted his/her dissertation under the direction of a member of the Graduate Faculty.
- The submitted dissertation has received a passing grade.
- The student has passed the final examinations.

Note that a student who has achieved excellent research results may be allowed to complete the Program earlier than scheduled (early completion, not applicable at some programs).

(ii) Requirements for doctorates (3-year Programs)

The Graduate School Steering Committee reviews the academic records of students who meet all the following requirements and determines whether to award them doctorates:

- The student has enrolled in his/her Doctoral Program for at least three years.
- The student has earned credits for the courses required for a doctorate specified in the relevant division's detailed rules (some of the Graduate Schools do not require credits).
- The student has completed and submitted his/her dissertation under the direction of a member of the Graduate Faculty.
- The submitted dissertation has received a passing grade.
- The student has passed the final examinations.

Note that a student who has achieved excellent research results may be allowed to complete the Program earlier than scheduled (early completion, not applicable at some programs).

(3) How to Submit a Master's Thesis/Doctoral Dissertation for Review

Submit your master's thesis or doctoral dissertation in duplicate, along with the following supporting documents, to the place designated by your Graduate School no later than a specified deadline: a complete request form for thesis/dissertation review (with your academic adviser's seal of approval on it); an abstract of the thesis/dissertation (up to 4,000 characters); two copies of an outline of the thesis/dissertation; two copies of your curriculum vitae; and a written confirmation of the integrity of the thesis/dissertation.

You are required to submit only one thesis/dissertation, but you may attach other theses as references. The submitted thesis/dissertation will not be returned.

(4) Schedule for Program Completion

(i) Completion of Master's Programs

Each Graduate School has its standard schedule for program completion. Please check with the Graduate School Academic Affairs of the relevant Academic Service Office for the information.

The next page shows the schedules for the review of theses/dissertations submitted by students who completed the program at the end of the last academic year for your reference (only the Graduate Schools with the Master's Programs that had graduates last year are included).

Students who have enrolled in the Master's Programs for at least two years (except for short-term enrollment programs), earned required credits, and completed their scholastic research under the direction of members of Graduate Faculty may complete their programs at the end of the Spring Semester. However, please check with the Graduate School Academic Affairs of the relevant Academic Service Office for the accurate schedule.
