Research field: Japanese Culture and Society (Japanese Culture in general, Japanese Sociology,

**Duties**: 1) teaching undergraduate classes related to the research field at the College of Japanese Language and Culture, 2) coordination of overseas student exchanges (sending students abroad in particular) at Global Commons and 3) involvement in the running of the College of Japanese Language and Culture and the Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences.

Requirements: 1) a Doctoral degree, or on course to obtain one soon, 2) must have publications in English, 3) sufficient Japanese proficiency (no nationality requirement), 3) a willingness and ability to engage in international academic exchanges and to communicate academic achievements globally

- 4. Summary of teaching engagement in the last 5 years A4 sheets, free format, stating the institution, class subject and the year
- 5. An essay on your future plans and ambitions in research and teaching A4 sheets, free format, in about 1200 words in Japanese
