Positions

Recruitment for excellent persons to fill one position at the level of Assistant Professor in the Tsukuba Plant Innovation Research Center (T-PIRC, Director Prof. Hiroshi Ezura), University of Tsukuba.

Term of appointments

From the date of adoption until March 31, 2022.

Field of research

We are seeking an assistant professor to conduct academic research in the field of plant science with the aim of becoming an international hub. The candidate will also belong to an appropriate graduate program (Biological Sciences, Biosphere Resource Science and Technology, or Bioindustrial Sciences), and an appropriate undergraduate program (Biological Sciences or Agro-Biological Resource Sciences) and educate students.

Teaching duties

The successful applicant will be in charge of research guidance of graduate students (Graduate School of Life and Environmental Sciences) and education of undergraduate students (College of Biological Sciences or Agro-Biological Resource Sciences).

Other responsibilities

Successful applicant must also take leadership roles in academic and scientific programs related to T-PIRC, University of Tsukuba.

Recruitments

- (1) Must have a doctoral or equivalent degree with professional record relevant to the fields of study in plant science.
- (2) Must have sufficient experience and knowledge in plant sciences to improve international competitiveness.
- (3) Candidate is also expected to have literacy skills in Japanese.

Earliest starting dates: After June 1, 2019.

Salary and allowances will be provided in accordance with the University of Tsukuba guidelines.

- 3) Summary of previous research and plan of proposed research (1 page)

- 5) Two letters of reference or two nominees with whom we may discuss the applicant's qualifications.
- 6) Copies of five scientific publications (journal articles, books)
