

The university system is made up of seven clusters of colleges, two schools, and three types of graduate schools (master's programs, doctoral programs, and professional degree programs).

As of May 1, 2011, 9,954 undergraduate students and

6,843 graduate school students were registered for a total of 16,797 students.

The university has 1,664 international students from 86 countries and regions, an indication of its internationalization.

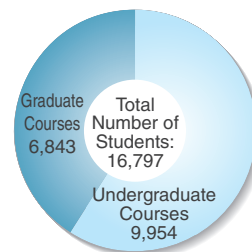
