As the Chief Scientist and the Director of National Tobacco Control Office, China CDC, Prof. Yang has given great contributions to tobacco control in China, particularly for the government of ratifying the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC). She has received the WHO Outstanding Contribution Award in Tobacco Control. Prof. Yang is a clinician and got the public health training in the Harvard University. She used to work as a Medical Officer in the World Bank and the WHO. Prof. Yang has edited or co-edited 23 books and has published more than 80 articles in scientific journals, including the N Eng J Med, Lancet, JAMA, BMJ, etc.

You will learn the current burden of chronic diseases such as cardiovascular diseases and cancer, risk profiles of them, tobacco control, and relevant health system on primary care, health service, and medical insurance in China.
