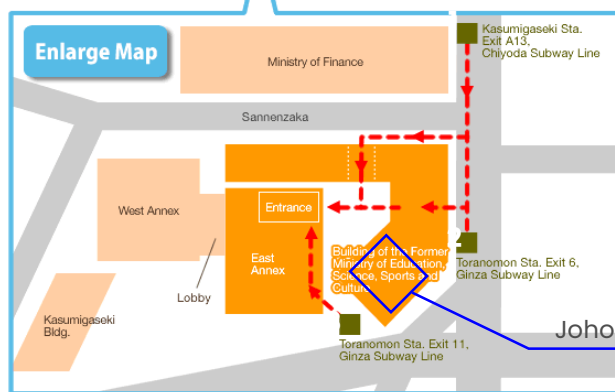


Access Map
