【修了要件】

3年以上在学し、看護科学学位プログラムが定める修了の要件として必要な授業科目の履修により所定の単位を修得し、かつ、必要な研究指導を受けた上、博士論文の審査及び最終試験に合格すること。ただし、在学期間に関しては、優れた研究業績を上げた者については1年(修士課程早期修了者等)にあっては当該過程における在学期間を含めて3年)以上在学すれば足りるものとする。

※教育上有益と認められる場合には、学位プログラムごとに定める範囲において、他の学位プログラムの授業科目の履修により修得した単位を修了の要件となる単位として認めることができる。

【Graduation requirements】

Students must be enrolled in the program for at least three years, earn the prescribed credits by completing the coursework required for completion as stipulated by Doctoral Program in Nursing Science, receive the necessary research guidance, and pass the doctoral dissertation review and final examination. However, it is sufficient for those who have achieved excellent research results to be enrolled for at least one year (three years including the period of enrollment in the relevant process in the case of those who have completed their master's degree early, etc.).

*When deemed educationally beneficial, credits earned by taking courses in other degree programs may be accepted as credits toward completion, within the limits specified for each degree program.
