Academic Computing and Communications Center (ACCC) manages various computer systems and software licenses in order to provide university members with the computing environment necessary for study, research and work. Below is a summary of the systems and software students can use: (Newly enrolled students will be able to use them AFTER enrollment.)

● Zengaku Computer System <https://www.u.tsukuba.ac.jp/en-toppage/>

+ **E-mail Address: Important messages from the university are sent to this e-mail address.**

Users can send and receive e-mail via their Zengaku Computer System e-mail account.

+ PCs (computer terminals): A total of more than 1000 PCs are available in 30 satellite computer rooms.

+ Publishing Web Content : Users can publish their personal website on the Zengaku Computer System.

● On-Campus Wi-Fi System https://www.cc.tsukuba.ac.jp/wp_e/service/wireless/

Users can connect their own device (such as a laptop or tablet) to the Internet via the Access Point Connections. To login to the Access Point Connections, they need to use their own Unified Authentication ID and password.

This system authenticates users to access the following systems:

- + Zengaku Computer System
- + TWINS (class registration)
- + Access Point Connections
- + manaba (learning management system)
