Notes on taking courses offered by TEACH

1. Students in the TEACH program must take 27 credits (90 ECTS) in total for the TEACH Core Subjects, and at each of universities 9 credits (30 ECTS).

2. TEACH program students who wish to obtain a Master's degree from University of Tsukuba, in addition to the "TEACH Core Subjects", which are equivalent to the required courses, must select and take extra courses as "Tsukuba-Subjects" from the courses of their belonging department, in order to fulfill the requirements for completion of their degree program.

3. TEACH Core Subjects (for a total of 9 credits) that TEACH program students must take at University of Tsukuba are listed below. All of these courses must be taken at University of Tsukuba.

(1) "Joint Research Seminar (T)" (3 Credits)

- (2) "Language Studies (T)" (3 Credits)
- (3) "Area Studies (T)" (3 Credits)

4. In the "Language Studies (T)," students must take two courses in German, Korean, or Japanese that are not their native language. In addition, students must take either "Japanese Language for IAJS" or "English Language for IAJS."

5. Students must take a total of at least 3 credits from "Area Studies" courses.

"Area Studies" courses must be selected from courses offered by Master's Program in International Advanced and Japanese Studies, Master's Program in International Public Policy, and Master's Programs in Humanities that have been previously listed as "Area Studies" courses by the TEACH Committee, based on the completion requirements of students' degree programs.
\*The correspondence between the TEACH program requirements and the degree program requirements will be explained individually at the TEACH orientation.
