(Curriculum)

Being enrolled in the school for at least two years, earning the required credits by completing the required courses as a requirement for completion as stipulated in this degree program, receiving the necessary research guidance, passing the master's thesis examination and the final exam. However, those who have achieved excellent achievements may reduce the period of the enrollment to one year minimum.

(Requirements)

■ Master's Program in Medical Sciences (M)
Students are required to earn 30 or more credits as follows:

- (1) Subjects for Medical Sciences General Foundation Subjects: 9 credits of Compulsory Subject (2 subjects below)
 - · Dissertation in Medical Sciences
 - Internship I
- (2) Subjects for Medical Sciences General Foundation Subjects (other than compulsory subjects), Foundation Subjects for Major, Major Subjects, Common Subjects, Graduate General Education and Subjects offered in other programs: 21credits or more

(Notice)

- (1) As for Elective subjects, Subjects Recommended must be taken in the field which you belong (Medical Scineces, Medical Physics or Critical Path Research).
- (2) Students are required to complete one of "Introduction to Academic Integrity" (Graduate General Education) or "Scientific Ethics" (Subjects for Medical Sciences), and to take the INFOSS course to take "Dissertation in Medical Sciences" (compulsory subject).
- (3) The subjects designated for the digree program may be included in Subjects for Medical Sciences.
- (4) Subjects in Graduate General Education or those offered in other degree programs may be counted up to six credits for the requirement of the completion of the program.
- (5) Subjects in Graduate General Education, those offered in other degree program, or Common Subjects may be counted up to 10 credits for the requirement of the completion of the program.
