## (Completion requirements)

Students must be enrolled in the program for at least two years, earn the prescribed credits, receive the necessary research guidance, and pass an examination of the results of their master's thesis or research on a specific topic, as well as a final examination. However, with regard to attendance period, it is sufficient for those who have made outstanding achievements to be enrolled for at least one year.
Students must earn at least 30 credits by the following methods.
(1) Specific foundation subjected to art - General foundation subjects At least 6 credits, including the Graduate School common specialized foundation courses (up to 2 credits of Common Foundation Subjects may be included)
(2) Art Studies Specific foundation subjects - Major Subject Research and Production Presentation Special seminar I and II, Master's Program in Art Special seminar, Master's Program in Art Special Studies (total 10 credit ) including 24 credit or above (select the most relevant courses, mainly in your main area of education and research)
The research for the completion of the program will be based on one of the following methods, which will evaluate the results of research ranging from pure theory to the results of research on specific issues, according to the characteristics of each specialized field.
a. Thesis, b. Works and thesis, c. Works and research reports
