### (How to Complete Course Requirements)

To complete the program, students must satisfy all of the following requirements (1) – (4):

- (1) Earn a total of at least 30 credits, including both compulsory and elective courses, as prescribed by this degree program.
- (2) Pass the degree examination.
- (3) Pass the final examination.
- (4) Be enrolled for at least two years. However, for students who have achieved particularly outstanding research accomplishments, enrollment for at least one year shall be deemed sufficient.

### (Course Registration Requirements)

- ① In addition to the required courses (9 credits) prescribed by the degree program, students must take the recommended courses in their selected field of study (Medical Sciences, Medical Physics, Critical Path Research, or Infectious Disease Crisis Management).
- ② Credits earned from Inter-disciplinary Foundation Courses, Graduate General Education Courses, and courses offered by other degree programs may be counted toward the completion requirements, up to a maximum of 10 credits. Of these, credits from Graduate General Education Courses and courses offered by other degree programs combined are limited to a maximum of 6 credits.
- ③ Earning credits in Introduction to Academic Integrity (Graduate General Education Courses) or Scientific Ethics (Subjects for Medical Sciences), as well as completion of INFOSS, are prerequisites for enrollment in Dissertation in Medical Sciences (compulsory subject).
