(Completion Requirements)

Students must be enrolled in the program for at least three years, acquire at least 15 credits by taking the required courses as specified below, receive necessary research supervision, and pass the Doctoral dissertation and the final examinations. However, for those who have made outstanding achievements, enrollment for at least one year is sufficient. (For those who have completed a master's program early, three years including the period of enrollment in the master's program.)

(1) 1 credit from Graduate General Education Courses or Degree Programs' Common Courses

(2) 12 credits – "Research Laboratory Seminar"

(3) 2 credits – "Research Laboratory Practice"

- Attending the "Research Ethics Guidance" provided by Degree Programs in Humanities and Social Sciences is a requirement for completion of the program.
- To submit a certificate of completion of the e-learning course (eL-CoRE or eAPRIN [formerly CITI Japan]) at the time of application for preliminary doctoral dissertation review is a requirement for completion of the program.
