Starting in AY 2027, some weekday and period field notations will change.

To make the weekday and period field notation easier to understand, some weekday and period notations will be revised as follows from AY 2027.

① Merge "By request (随時)" into "By appointment (応談)".

In addition, the english notation of "By appointment (応談)" after the merger will be "By arrangement (応談)".

(Reason) "By request" and "By arrangement" have traditionally been used with similar meanings, so combining them will make the wording clearer.

(Previously)

随時 By request	This is a course format in which students, while engaged in activities such as laboratory work for extended periods—particularly in courses with a strong practical focus—receive guidance from instructors as needed, following consultation with them.
応談 By appointment	This refers to a course format typically held on a regular basis, such as small-group seminars, but where changes to the schedule—often due to faculty availability—occur fairly frequently.

(Starting in AY 2027)

応談 By arrangement	This is a course format in which the schedule is determined flexibly based on the situation. Examples: Small-group seminar-style courses, laboratory instruction-based courses, practical skills courses, internship courses, language training courses, graduation research projects, etc.
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② Change "NT" to "Full On-Demand."

(Reason) "NT" stands for "Non-timetabled attendance is possible," but since it was difficult to understand what the abbreviation meant without checking the Course Catalogue or similar resources, we are changing the weekday and period field notation to "Full On-Demand" based on the course delivery method (full on-demand).

(Points to Note)

1. As before, courses listed as "Full On-Demand" in the weekday and period field are those conducted online (on-demand) that do not have a specific day/period assigned. For courses that are on-demand but have specific day/period, the weekday and period field will display a notation other than "Full On-Demand."

2. As always, please plan your coursework carefully, using the recommended weekday and period, etc. listed in the syllabus as a guide, and be sure to keep track of deadlines for report submission, etc.

Please note that while you may enroll in other courses offered at the same time as the recommended weekday and period, etc., you should carefully consider whether you can manage the workload—including assignments—and plan your course load accordingly.

《Important Notice!!》

As part of the process to update KdB to reflect the above changes, the weekday and period field notation for courses offered prior to AY 2026 will also be updated to the new format by August 2026.
