<u>Private Sector English Proficiency Tests for Graduate School Entrance Examination</u> (February) for Academic Year 2021 of University of Tsukuba

University of Tsukuba has decided to handle the English tests for Graduate School Entrance Examination (February) for Academic Year 2021 as follows. The Application Guidelines which are now posted will be revised as needed.

1. Scores of TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition

When applying for programs that require an English test score, refer to the application guidelines (TOEIC, TOEFL iBT, IELTS, etc.). It is also acceptable to submit a TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition score.

Note that it has been decided that the TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition will continue to be implemented from 2021 onwards, and its name will be changed from "TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition" to "TOEFL iBT Home Edition".

Please note that as of July 27, 2020, TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition is conducted for a limited period through September 30, 2020. Please check the official website for details.

Note) As a result, the Doctoral Program in Sports Medicine, Degree Programs in Comprehensive Human Sciences, and Graduate School of Comprehensive Human Sciences accept TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition and TOEFL iBT Test, in addition to the TOEIC Listening & Reading Test.

2. How to submit TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition and TOEFL iBT Test scores

When submitting a TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition score, please make sure to complete both of the following steps. You can apply for the programs with the original of the Test Taker Score Report, but the original of the Test Taker Score Report delivery may be delayed. When it is expected that you cannot submit the Test Taker Score Report by the due date, please make sure to complete the following step b. For those who cannot submit the original of the Test Taker Score Report applications will be regarded as not accepted or absent, and will not be considered for selection.

a. Test Take Score Report

- Please submit the original of the Test Taker Score Report to the office in charge of application by the due date mentioned in the Application Guidelines.

- When it is considered that the original will not arrive by the due date,

please complete the following procedure b, download and print the PDF copy from your ETS account, and submit it by the due date. Also submit the original soon after it arrives.

- Your application or acceptance will be revoked if a falsehood is found in the score submitted.

b. Official Score Report

- Please be sure that you ask ETS to send the Official Score Report directly to the university.
