Outline	Faculty of Library, Information and Media Science, of the University of Tsukuba invites applications for the position of associate professor in informatics. The faculty seeks applicants who are capable of conducting research and teaching on knowledge discovery from and management of bigdata on crowd activities, aiming at improving productivity, achieving trust, and creating motivations in lives, in the crowd-in-the-loop society. The applicants are expected to be motivated to develop a better framework of division of labor and new services based on them, exploiting knowledge behind sequence data such as crowd action logs and task results in the form of structured data and natural language data. Expected knowledge and skills include data mining, data integration, data analysis, and data management. Applicants are also expected to be interested in both theory and implementation.
