Overview of Position: The successful applicant is required to teach and conduct research in the bioindustrial science on genetic resources at University of Tsukuba and research will be conducted jointly UT's collaborating institutions overseas. In particular, engage in research on international collaboration of beneficial microorganisms and provide legal compliance supports on implementation. The candidate is expected to work alongside with faculty members and research teams on campus. As an international/student support work of the Global

Commons which is the central function of international actions at UT, provides guidance and consultation to international students on campus life as well as Japanese students studying abroad. In addition, the applicant is also in charge for teaching graduate students mostly in Bioindustrial Sciences.

Qualifications and Experiences:

- Ph. D in relevant field (Less than 10 years after obtaining doctorate degree or to be awarded by the end of March, 2020)
- Fluency in Japanese and English, is essential as the candidate is required to teach in both Japanese and English. On top of a common certificate of English, the implementation ability will be evaluated during the interview process. Candidate who can speak language outside the East-Asian region, is desirable for counseling the international students with various nationalities).
