Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at the University of Tsukuba is seeking applicants for the post of Associate or Assistant Professor.

1. Position

A full-time tenured Associate Professor or tenure-track Assistant Professor

2. Field of Study

Humanities and social sciences related to Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

3. Affiliation

Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences

4. Responsibilities

- (1) Promoting research on SDGs at Institute for Comparative Research in Human and Social Sciences (ICR).
- (2) Teaching cross-disciplinary courses related to SDGs in postgraduate degree programs in humanities and social sciences.
- (3) Teaching undergraduate courses for Bachelor's Program in Global Issues including its foundation subjects for major and practical training/seminars to be taught in English.

5. Qualifications

- (1) Doctoral degree in humanities and social sciences related to SDGs 1 (poverty), 5 (gender equality), 10 (equality), 16 (peace and justice), etc.
- (2) Ability to teach courses in English
- (3) Working ability in Japanese is preferred

6. Start of Employment

April 1, 2020 or later

7. Term of Employment

Associate professor: tenured.

Assistant professor: Five years. Tenure review will be conducted in the fifth year. A candidate receiving satisfactory evaluation will be awarded tenure.

* Salary is based on age, qualifications, and experience, as per university policy.

* Annual salary system is applied; a commutation allowance is paid in addition.

- (1) Curriculum Vitae, including a detailed description of the applicant's educational background, academic and other professional activities, date of birth, nationality, home and office addresses
- (2) A copy or photocopy of five main publications during the last five years
- (3) List of all publications and presentations
- (4) List of teaching experience during the last three years
- (5) Essay on teaching and research plans at the University of Tsukuba (up to 400 words)
- (6) Cover letter with the applicant's email address and telephone number
- (7) Contact information of two references (name, affiliation, email address, phone number, etc.)
