<IMPORTANT> Japan Pre-Entry Tuberculosis Screening

Since the end of border control measures regarding COVID-19, the number of people entering Japan from abroad has increased, resulting in a significant increase in the number of foreign-born tuberculosis patients. For the reason, the Japanese Government has decided to sequentially begin conducting a tuberculosis screening on people those who wish to enter and reside in Japan as mid-to long-term residents from **the Philippines**, **Nepal**, **Vietnam**, **Indonesia**, **Myanmar and China** before entering the country. (You will not be eligible if it is confirmed by residence permit etc. that your current residence is in a country or region other than the target countries.)

Those who hold nationality of the eligible countries and apply for a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) after the dates listed below, you will need to submit a "Tuberculosis (TB) Clearance Certificate" at the time of application.

•<u>The Philippines, Nepal</u>···June 23, 2025

·<u>Vietnam</u>····September 1, 2025

·Indonesia, Myanmar, China ···· Not decided

* TB Clearance Certificate " is issued by foreign medical institutions designated by the Japanese Government.

The "TB Clearance Certificate " must be submitted to the Immigration Bureau when applying for your COE. Without the certificate, your COE application will not be accepted.
