Important Notes

- Please bring your student ID card and come to take the health examination at a designated date and time. If you cannot do so due to unavoidable circumstances, please come at another date and time in the table above and finish it by the morning of April 24.
- Current students should take the health examination by the morning of April 24. After then new year students will be prioritized.
- For those who are non-degree research students, exchange students, research students or credited auditors, please have the checkup on a designated date for each academic affiliation.
- The reception is at University Hall 2F.
- Please come to Academic Service Offices after April 1, to obtain the urinalysis containers for the checkup beforehand. You need to bring your first urine on the checkup day.
(Students, who leave the container at home, need to come to Academic Service Offices. We do not have the containers at the site.)
- As for the chest radiography (exam of having tuberculosis or not), only the first grade students are expected to undergo it in laws and ordinances.
However, the other students also can have this occasion:
-The student who has problems with the chest conditions such as coughs, sputum, pain, or shortness of breath.
-The student who needs to submit medical examination reports for any training or employment.
Note: Please wear plain T-shirts beforehand or bring it when you have the health examination.
Long-haired students should do up in a knot when taking the health examination.
- Degree-seeking undergraduate and graduate students can get a health certificate by using automatic certificate issuing machines (TWINS) after the health examinations. The university will post a notification on its homepage when ready. In case the automatic certificate issuing machines couldn't issue your health certificate, please ask University Health Center for help.
- Please make sure to take the health examination so the university can issue a health certificate.
- Regarding Tokyo campus, students who do not have any plan for taking medical checkup, please have an opportunity for the staff medical examination of Tokyo and Chiba district. The outline is prepared separately.
